The Human Resource Committee of the BCAS, under the aegis of the BCAS Foundation, has been contributing to various socio-economic development projects and Tree Plantation in and around the Dharampur area, Gujarat, for over 12 years now. This year we have planned to create a "BCAS VAN" at the Gangol Village, Taluka Diyodar, Dist. Banaskantha. (Please see the details at the end of this Announcement). We will also have a symbolic tree plantation at Umargam, as mentioned below:

Visit to Umargam

1. Tree Plantation

In addition to the mega tree plantations at the Bansakantha, a symbolic tree plantation will be carried out at Umargam with the support of the MABAP Foundation, an NGO engaged in the areas of education and upliftment of tribals and poor people as well socio-economic and socio-spiritual activities.

2. Visit to Tribal Schools

We are glad to inform you that BCAS Foundation has been instrumental in setting up 25 digital classrooms in tribal schoolsin the Vevji area, Talasari, near Umargam. These digital classrooms fill the gap of shortage of teachers and impart teaching to children with modern technology and modern methods. The response from students and teachers is amazing. We shall visit a few such schools and have a first-hand experience of this project.

3. Visit to Bhaskar Save's Organic/Natural Farm

Late Bhaskar Save was known as "Gandhi of Natural Farming in India". He was an extraordinary educator, trainer, entrepreneur, farmer, and activist. Today his children are promoting natural/organic farming in a big way. We shall learn and educate ourselves with first-hand experience of visit to his organic farm spread over 30 acres of land situated in Umargam.
