Notes:

- 1- The Corinthians Resort and Club, Pune is about 18 kms from Pune Airport and 12 Kms from Pune Railway Station and estimated travel time will be around 40 minutes and 25 minutes respectively. Regular taxis are available from the airport and Railway station to reach the Hotel. Participants are required to make their own arrangements to reach the Hotel.
