Income Tax Aspects of Redevelopment of Society

Dear Members,

Redevelopment of housing societies carries income tax implications such as capital gains tax on property transfer, rental income taxation and TDS obligations on payments made by developers. Stamp duty and registration charges add to costs. Exemptions under Sections 54 and 54F can reduce capital gains tax burden if proceeds are reinvested. Clubbing of income may occur in certain scenarios. Additionally, GST may apply based on services provided. Professional advice is crucial for navigating tax laws, ensuring compliance and maximizing available benefits.

Hence, the Suburban Study Circle of BCAS has planned a session to spread awareness among Chartered Accountants on income tax aspects of redevelopment of society in **Borivali**.
