This year, we are planning a social causes visit to Vada & Umargam for the following objectives :

1. Tree plantation at Vada tribal village as captive plantation:

We are planning to undertake tree plantation with the dual purpose of environmental conservation, as well as captive plantation on farmers' land, to help them generate income in the future. We have planned the BCAS Tree Plantation Project at a village in Vada – Palghar. We are also planning a symbolic tree plantation at Vada.
