With the limitation for issuing Section 74 notices for FY 2018-19 having expired on 30.06.2025, taxpayers across the country have been flooded with notices—many raising diverse and questionable issues. The deadline for passing orders in these cases (31.12.2025) is fast approaching. A similar wave of notices for FY 2019-20 is expected soon, with the limitation expiring on 30.09.2025.

In this context, we have planned our next study circle meeting to discuss key aspects including:

- When can Section 74 be invoked? (Understanding fraud, suppression, misstatement)
- Common defects in SCNs (Boilerplate language, lack of evidence, vague allegations)
- Strategies for effective response (Legal grounds, pre-SCN consultation, procedural safeguards)
- Judicial trends and departmental approach (Recent case laws and practical experiences)
