## ***Lecture Meeting on Decision of Supreme Court in Tiger Global and it's ramifications***

Dear Members,

Recently, the Supreme Court in a landmark judgement upheld the taxability in the hands of Tiger Global, on the sale transaction of Flipkart shares to Walmart under the India – Mauritius tax treaty. While upholding the taxability, the Supreme Court also held on the issue of sanctity and sufficiency of the Tax Residency Certificate as well as the applicability of the grandfathering provisions under the India – Mauritius tax treaty to indirect transfers.

Keeping in mind the significant implications this decision could have on practitioners in international tax, the Society has organized a lecture meeting, in the form of an explanation followed by a panel discussion, covering various issues in the judgement as well as its ramifications on other transactions and the benefit availed under tax treaties, in general.
