The forthcoming year marks a watershed moment in Indian direct taxation with the introduction of the Income-tax Act, 2025, effective from 1st April 2026. This new legislation represents a comprehensive overhaul of the existing framework, aiming to simplify provisions, reduce interpretational ambiguity and align the law with modern economic realities. The accompanying Income-tax Rules, 2026 further rationalise the regulatory framework, significantly reducing the number of rules and forms while enhancing clarity and ease of compliance.

At the same time, the professional landscape continues to evolve rapidly. Increased digitisation, faceless tax administration, data-driven scrutiny and the growing integration of Artificial Intelligence (AI) and analytics are fundamentally transforming the manner in which tax practice is conducted. Professionals today are expected not only to interpret the law but also to navigate technology-driven environments, manage compliance risks and provide strategic, forward-looking advice to clients.

In this backdrop, there is a pressing need to revisit foundational concepts while simultaneously equipping oneself with practical insights and emerging perspectives under the new regime. DTHRC 2026 has been carefully curated to address this need by combining conceptual clarity, practical application and discussion on contemporary issues and controversies. The course aims to enable participants to confidently transition into the new law while enhancing their advisory and litigation capabilities. The course will be spread over 7 days with 2 sessions each day. Participants who are unable to attend any session may access the recorded videos, which will be made available after completion of the course.
