Webinar on Charitable Trusts – Recent Developments

The regulatory landscape governing charitable and religious trusts in India is undergoing rapid and continuous transformation, driven by frequent legislative amendments, evolving judicial interpretations, and increasingly stringent compliance requirements. Recent changes under the Income-tax law, coupled with developments in allied regulations such as the Maharashtra Public Trusts Act and the Foreign Contribution Regulation Act (FCRA), have significantly expanded the scope and depth of compliance obligations.

At the same time, there is a heightened focus by regulatory authorities on transparency, accountability, and proper utilisation of funds, resulting in closer scrutiny of registrations, approvals and ongoing operations of trusts. In this evolving environment, it is essential for trustees, professionals, and advisors to remain well-informed and proactive in order to effectively manage compliance, mitigate risks, and preserve tax exemptions.

To address these evolving challenges, Direct Tax Committee of the Bombay Chartered Accountants' Society jointly with IMC Chamber of Commerce and Industry is organising a **Webinar on “Charitable Trusts – Recent Developments.”**

The webinar aims to provide participants with a practical, relevant and up-to-date perspective on key developments impacting charitable trusts, with a focus on real-world application in areas such as registration, taxation and regulatory oversight.
